Pinewood Derby

The **Pinewood Derby Weigh-in** is Monday, March 15th, 6:30-8:00 p.m. in the cafeteria. You (or at least your car) **must** make the weigh-in. Your car will be kept and displayed at school until the race. It should only take a few minutes to weigh each car. Our official scale will be available in the school office beginning March 1st to check your car's weight. Be as close to the 5-oz. maximum weight as possible. **The races will be held Tuesday, March 16th, 6:30-8:30 p.m. in the gym.** Trophies for the top three places will be awarded in each grade level.

Girl Cubs Pinewood Derby

Open to any girl with a brother in Pack 82. Currently we have several female drivers registered in our Pinewood Derby. These girls will compete in their own race-off after the boys are finished. These cars **must** make the Monday night weigh-in and all of the same rules apply.

 - Biggest Cake
 - Tallest Cake
 - Flattest Cake
 - Best Cub Scout Theme
